 1. Explanation of the Girls STEM Collaborative grants and program
 - ITMC
 - a) ITMC's grant will be between \$500-\$1,000
 - b) Must benefit the citizens of Montana in some way
 - c) Be IT in nature
 - d) Final product is presented to the ITMC by them
 - Girls STEM Group
 - a) Any project must be a part of Science, Technology, Engineering or Math
 - b) Used to attract and recruit girls to become interested in STEM
 - c) Any group is allowed, even groups with boys, but must include girls and item (b) above
 - d) The National Science Foundation (NSF) Established Program to Stimulate Competitive Research (EPSCoR) Section

 - "An independent federal agency created by congress in 1950, to promote the progress of science; to advance the national health, prosperity and welfare; to secure the national defense."
 - Grant money will be combined with the ITMC grant to help
 - e) 3 tracts for the Program
 - Water
 - Technology
 - "Special Package" – this is us ☺☺
 2. Expectations of the workgroup
 - How much time can each of us commit?
 - Fast -paced timeline so we will need to meet more often
 - a) Group agreed to brownbag lunches
 - Communicate via email and Skype
 3. Timeline of the program
 - 15 March - Press Release
 - 1 April to 3 May – applications to online system
 - 4 May – begin application evaluation
 - Mentorship and support the group to last no more than 1 year
